AVIAN INFLUENZA UPDATE



In Ontario, there have been 21 infected premises identified to date. Each infected premise is under quarantine and the 10KM Control Zones around the premises are established. CFIA continues to monitor and control movement of poultry and poultry products in, out and through these established zones.

Floradale Feed Mill continues to exercise extremely heightened bio-security as per CFIA and FBCC guidelines; this includes, but is not limited to, increased disinfection procedures, including spraying trucks and tires upon entering all poultry farms and upon return to mill, reducing truck movements in and around the zones, and limiting staff visits to poultry farms within the Control Zones.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

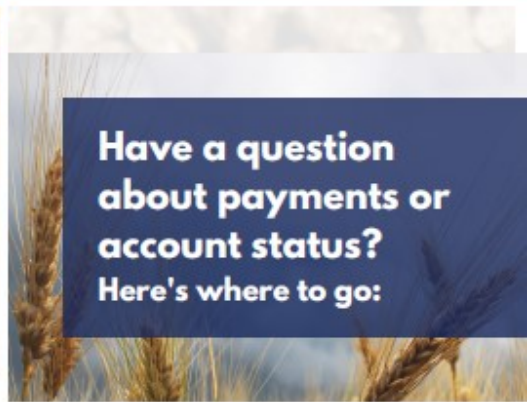
With the arrival of spring weather, it is important to note that the AI virus thrives in cool, wet conditions. Producers are reminded to apply heightened biosecurity and to continue to control movements into your premise, especially if you are located within a Primary Control Zone.

The ministry is reminding producers of the importance of deadstock management. Of the 46 wild birds confirmed HPAI positive, five are turkey vultures.
